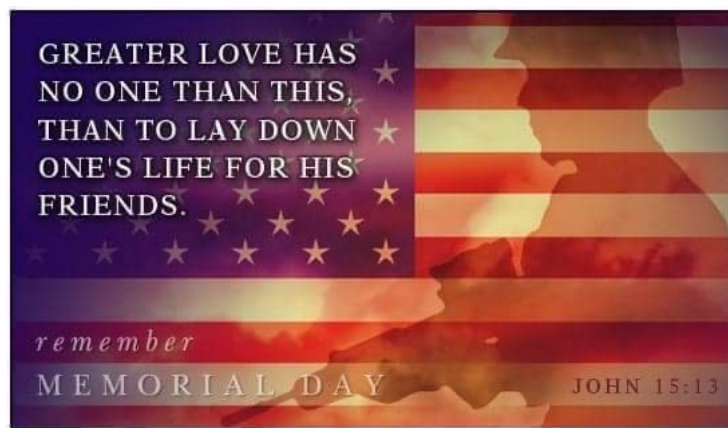
Mother's Day

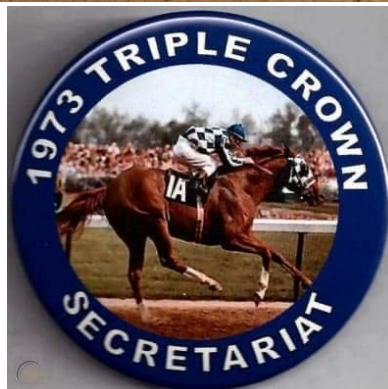
Memorial Day

The Kentucky Derby

The Kentucky Derby is a horse race held annually in Louisville, Kentucky, United States, almost always on the first Saturday in May, capping the two week long Kentucky Derby Festival. It is dubbed the Run for the Roses, stemming from the blanket of roses draped over the winner. It is also known in the United States as the most exciting two minutes in sports or the fastest two minutes in sports because of its approximate duration. It is the first leg of the American Triple Crown, followed by the Preakness Stakes, and then the Belmont Stakes. Of the three triple crown races, the Kentucky Derby had the distinction of having been run uninterrupted for 144 years previous to 2020. A horse must win all three races to win the Triple Crown. The 147th Kentucky Derby is scheduled for Saturday May 1st 2021 and will be broadcast on NBC.
